Tutoring

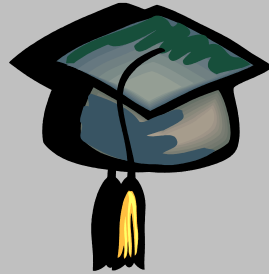
Professional and student tutors are available to help students develop effective study skills and behaviors that lead to academic achievement.

HEOP

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

All applicants must meet the following criteria:

Residency

Must have been a resident of New York State for the year immediately prior to the year of college enrollment.

Education

- Must be a high school graduate or have a New York State Equivalency diploma (G.E.D.) with a minimum score of 25.
- Must have taken the SAT or ACT exams.

Economic Guidelines

Must be economically disadvantaged as defined by the State Education Department Guidelines (see chart) and demonstrate a history of poverty.

Transfer Students

Must have been enrolled in HEOP or in another opportunity program such as College Discovery, SEEK or EOP at their previous school. Must be in good academic standing, submit a current college transcript and a HEOP transfer application form.

HEOP is more than a program, it's a built-in family. The program promotes growth, knowledge and provides different degrees of support. Ultimately, it is what you make of it.

All applicants must submit the following forms:

1. Fordham University Admissions Application
2. Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) scores
3. High school transcript (or G.E.D. scores)
4. Free Application For Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
5. Tuition Assistance Form (TAP)
6. Verification of income (tax return or letter from the appropriate social service agency)
