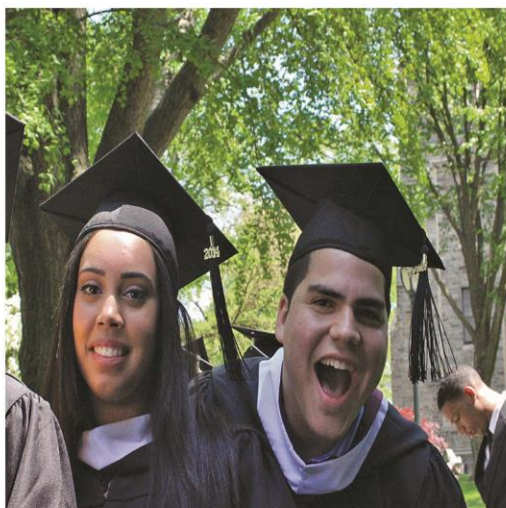


# HEOP WORKS!



## WHAT DOES HEOP OFFER YOU?

### SUMMER PROGRAM

All incoming freshmen are required to enroll in an intensive summer program. Upon successful completion of this program, students are awarded academic credits towards their degree.

### FINANCIAL AID

Grants are provided to all HEOP eligible students. Although these grants cover only a portion of the costs, the College combines funds from a variety of sources to complete their financial aid package.

### ACADEMIC ADVISING

Students meet with their HEOP counselor throughout the academic year to discuss their progress, plans, and goals.

### TUTORING

Professional and student tutors are available to help students develop effective study skills and behaviors that lead to academic achievement.

## THE HIGHER EDUCATION OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM

was created by New York State to help economically and academically disadvantaged students attend private colleges and universities. The Higher Education Opportunity Program at Fordham College at Lincoln Center provides a broad range of support services to assure that as many HEOP students as possible become Fordham University graduates.

## FINANCIAL ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES for 2015-16

| Number of members in household                    | Total Annual Income earned in 2014 |
|---|------------------------------------|
| 1   | \$21,775                           |
| 2   | \$29,471                           |
| 3   | \$37,167                           |
| 4   | \$44,863                           |
| 5   | \$52,559                           |
| 6   | \$60,255                           |

## ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

All applicants must meet the following criteria:

### RESIDENCY

- Must have been a resident of New York State for the year immediately prior to the year of college enrollment.

### EDUCATION

- Must be a high school graduate or have a New York State Equivalency diploma (G.E.D.) with a minimum score of 25. Must have taken the SAT or ACT exams.

### ECONOMIC GUIDELINES

- Must be economically disadvantaged as defined by the State Education Department Guidelines (see chart) and demonstrate a history of poverty.

### TRANSFER STUDENTS

- Must have been enrolled in HEOP or in another opportunity program such as College Discovery, SEEK or EOP at their previous school. Must be in good academic standing, submit a current college transcript and a HEOP transfer application form.
