



College and Career Resource Centers (CCRC)

Throughout the five boroughs, the College and Career Resource Center staff provides a range of services to students in Pathways to Graduation to support and guide their postsecondary readiness. The services offered at each borough's Hub (staffed by a CCRC Coordinator) and at the satellite sites (staffed by CCRC Coaches) include:

- Exploring colleges and assisting students with college applications
- Helping students understand college financial aid options and completing financial aid applications
- Organizing college campus tours, job shadows, career and college fairs, and related events
- Facilitating career exploration and job searches
- Assistance with creating résumés and cover letters
- Connecting students to vocational training and certification programs
- Informing parents and guardians about the college and career process

CCRC VISION

100% of students plan for and enter into a postsecondary program that leads to economic viability and personal fulfillment.

CCRC MISSION

Under the guidance of the College and Career Resource Centers, in collaboration with Pathways to Graduation staff and partners, ALL students will seek inspiration, acquire knowledge and take action through active participation in workshops, experiences, creating an individual learning plan (ILP), and by ultimately enrolling in post-secondary program.

CCRC GOALS AND OUTCOMES

- 1. Inspire students to understand and pursue postsecondary opportunities upon graduation;
- 2. Educate students so they can make informed decisions about postsecondary plans;
- 3. Ensure all students complete an Individual Learning Plan through Plan to Succeed;
- 4. Ensure entry into a postsecondary program (as defined by acceptance and registration at a college, postsecondary training program, or career pathway in a company)

CCRC IMPLEMENTATION

CCRC staff in each borough schedule CCRC student workshops and individual sessions, ongoing satellite visits, student drop-in hours, parent workshops, and college and career related tours, trips, and events, and communicate these schedules to Hub- and satellite-based staff on an ongoing basis. The CCRCs welcome ongoing communication and collaboration with Pathways to Graduation faculty to ensure students graduate our programs with college and career readiness and a postsecondary plan.
