College Transition & Retention Data

- An average 0f 11,000 people passed the GED test in NYC (FY 2011); 36% (4,000) of them entered City University of New York (CUNY). Future Now's college transition rate is 89%.
- Out of the 4,000 GED recipients who entered CUNY in FY 2011, 71% needed Math remediation Courses. This year 88% of FN students avoided lower remediation courses after taking College-Prep Classes.
- Bronx Community College's One-Year Persistence Rate is 58%; Future Now's One-Year Persistence Rate is 70%.









