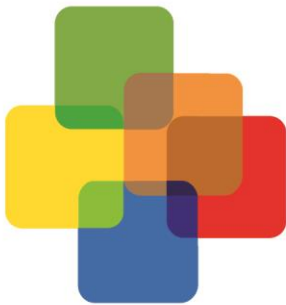




## **GED® Plus Has a New Name!**

Beginning in January, the GED® will no longer be administered in New York State. It will be replaced with the TASC® (Test Assessing Secondary Completion) which will continue to lead students to a High School Equivalency Diploma (HSED).

From now on, GED Plus will be called **Pathways to Graduation: Preparing for high school equivalency and beyond** and will remain a **free** high school equivalency preparation program for 18-21 year old students. Pathways to Graduation will continue to provide students with the academic and personal supports necessary for successful entry to college and career pathways upon graduation.
