Navigating the New CUNY Application

Key Things to Know

- 1. Use Firefox or Internet Explorer NOT Chrome
- 2. Students can **only hit submit once**. Afterwards they can add Supplemental Materials but not change choices, email or contact info.
- 3. The hardest question is the first one: Have you attended any College, University and/or Post-Secondary School <u>since</u> graduating from High School/Secondary School?

 → NO (even with College Now, ECI, College Credit)
- 4. **Supplemental Materials** should be included if it's required by the school/major **OR** if the student is "on the bubble" and it might nudge them towards acceptance.
- 5. Optional Sections are OPTIONAL- ONLY pick things you want clearly highlighted
 - a. Don't need to include Military Status, Ethnicity, Languages, Family Information
 - b. Don't need to include all HS and College Courses they'll get the transcripts
 - c. Don't need to include Extracurricular Activities
- 6. Get to know your CUNYFirst
 - a. Login and scroll down to Admissions \rightarrow View details \rightarrow List of to-dos or acceptance
 - b. Financial Aid will be there too

Tips by Application Section

1. Personal Information

- a. Student does not need to identify as undocumented (can pick other)
- b. Skip SSN and come back to add it later (BEFORE submission) if don't know it

2. Background Information

- a. Optional: Military Status, Ethnicity, Languages, Family Information
- b. Residency: Select the 2 NYC options (or all 4)

3. Academic Interest

a. CHANGE: Student can only list each college once with one major, can't select liberal arts as well as engineering.

4. Educational Experience

- a. Optional: High School Courses / College Courses
- Colleges will get the transcript but can highlight AP/College Now/College Courses

5. Supplemental Information

- a. Optional: SAT Scores (they'll need the score report)
- b. Optional: Extracurricular Activities highlight the best one
- c. Depends: Recommendations
 - Include when required for school or program (see CUNY list)
 - Community Colleges do not require recommendation letters
 - Include when student is "on the bubble" and might need the nudge into acceptance.
 - One recommendation is enough.
 - Recommendations are triggered when students submit. So don't wait to submit Macaulay until the deadline because then Letters of Recommendation are rushed. Can submit and then add your essays.
- d. Depends: Supplemental Materials
 - Include resume, personal statement if required or if on the bubble
